Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology (CCMB), Hyderabad. The fellowships will be carried out under the guidance of eminent scientists for a period of two months from May to June, 2018. The students will receive a monthly stipend, accommoda-

The admission will be purely based on merit & by following the reservation policy applied to Vignans University.
