Dr.M.Y.S.Prasad, Vice-Chancellor released the Vignan's University Admission Notification for the academic year 2018-19 towards admission into B.Tech programmes, BBA, BCA, B.Sc, M.Tech, MBA, MCA and Ph.D programmes. On this occasion, he said that in B.Tech Agricultural, Automobile, Biotechnology, Bio-Informatics, Biomed-

ical, Chemical, Civil, CSE, ECE, EEE, Food Technology, IT, Mechanical, Petroleum Engineering and Textile and Fashion Technology courses are offered. The Vice Chancellor further informed that admission into B.Pharmacy course is offered from this academic year. Admissions into B.Tech and B.Pharmacy programmes will be

based on the performance in the "Vignan's Scholastic Aptitude Test (V- SAT)", an online examination conducted on an all India basis. From this academic year, innovative courses such as Cloud Computing, Internet of Things (IOT), Scripting Lan-

guages, Artificial Intelligence, Rapid Prototyping, Nanotechnology, Biotechnology – Immunology, Immunoinformatics are carefully designed and implemented in the curriculum of appropriate programmes.



SAC sets its agenda for next semester

With the first semester of academic year 2017-18 coming to an end, Student Activities Council conducted a team meeting on 9th Nov 2017 after the completion of Mid examinations to set their agenda for the 2nd semester. The meeting was chaired by the faculty advisor, SAC- Mr. M.Anirudh and Vice President, SAC- Mr.Siddharth. * Requesting first year HoD to permit all the first year students to participate in optional clubs and also to provide a slot in their time table.

* All the optional clubs have been categorized into two groups and clubs in each group will be organised on every alternate day after the class hours.
