In this article authors inferred that *Pila globosa* from different geographical regions within

North-East India formed a single cluster and displayed a paraphyletic relationship with other Indian ampullariid, *Pila Virens*. Interesting and novel observation is that the generated molecular phylogenetic analysis using 18S rDNA among the species of *Pila* from India, Africa and Vietnam authenticated the paleomagnetic data showing that India collided with Asia around 57 mya possibly in the early Cenozoic era.
