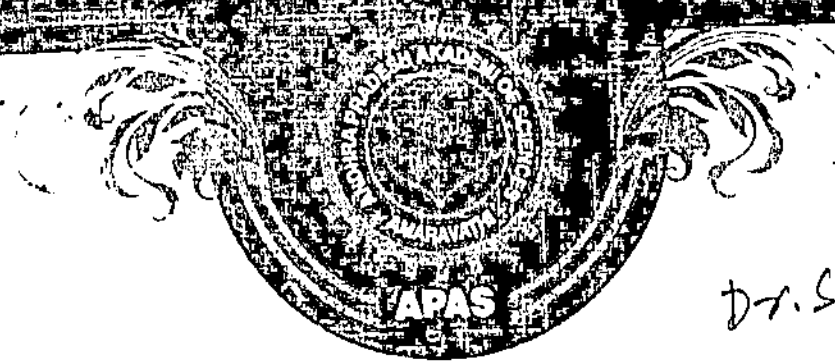



13. The project File no. EEQ/2017/000626 may also be mentioned in all research communications arising from the above project with due acknowledgement of SERB.





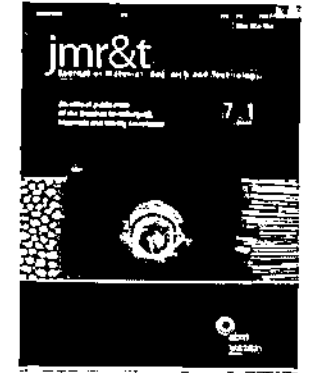
