

Scheme of Merit Scholarships

1. This scheme is called “Scheme of Merit Scholarships to the students of Vignan Foundation for Science, Technology & Research University, 2013”
2. This scheme comes into effect from the academic year 2013-14
3. The object of this scheme is to encourage meritorious students ranging from full fee waiver/50% fee waiver and 25% fee waiver basing on the merit criteria.
4. Method for awarding Merit scholarships:
 1. Students with no backlogs in the academic year and having 75% marks (including minor subjects) shall be considered for awarding the scholarships. They should have passed all subjects in the 1st attempt.
 2. b) Top 5% of the students registered for examinations shall be awarded the merit scholarships / fee waiver. The number of scholarships / fee waiver should be rounded off to the nearest integer.
 3. c) If students with same percentage marks are to be awarded, highest eligible scholarship shall to be sanctioned to both the students.
 4. d) The maximum amount of the fee waiver / scholarship given to any student shall be limited to the amount out of the
 - a) fee paid by the student or
 - b) category ‘A’ fee whichever is less
5. **Applicable to 2010 admitted B.Tech. students.**

Top 5% of the students shall be eligible for the awards out of which

Full fee waiver (Rs. 86,000/-) shall be granted to first 1/3rd of eligible students.

Half fee waiver (Rs. 43,000/-) shall be granted to second 1/3rd of eligible students.

Remaining students in top 5% shall be granted fee waiver of Rs. 20,000/-

6. 6) Procedure for awarding the scholarships to the B.Tech students admitted in 2011 and further batches and for PG students of all academic years.

Merit scholarships shall be awarded by considering performance of students of all branches put together when the syllabus is common.

When the syllabus is different from branch to branch merit scholarships will be awarded branch wise.

Distribution of merit scholarships:

First 1/3rd of the 5% students shall be awarded - 50% of category – A Fee
Second 1/3rd of the 5% students shall be awarded - 30% of category – A
Fee

Remaining students in the 5% shall be awarded - 20% of category – A fee
