

1. **Vignan's Foundation for Science, Technology and Research University (Vignan's University), India and Tomsk Polytechnic University, Russia** agree to become parties to this Memorandum, the purpose of which is to encourage and promote educational and academic exchanges and cooperation / collaboration between the two universities.
 2. Within disciplines that are **mutually acceptable and convenience basis**, both Parties undertake to pursue:
 - i. *Exchange of faculty, staff, and researchers for International internship for the purposes of research, teaching and development.*
 - ii. *Exchange of students for Dual Degree (2+2 or 3+1) or for internship, or for semester abroad program.*
 - iii. *Exchange academic materials, research publications and information, where each party respects copyright and intellectual property rights.*
 - iv. *Conducting joint research projects and research collaboration, joint publications in the areas of mutual interest to both Parties.*
 - v. *Any other agreed joint academic development activities.*
 3. The parties may conclude specific agreements that are mutually agreed upon for the purposes of implementing programs and/or activities pursuant to the provisions of this Memorandum. Such specific agreements shall define the relevant programs and/or activities concerned.

4. Both parties accept that any further activity under this Memorandum is subject to the availability of financial resources, and that supply of resources should be negotiated prior to activity.
5. Each Party may request in writing a modification or amendment of any part of this Memorandum. Any modification or amendment agreed upon by both Parties shall be written down. Such modification or amendments once approved by both Parties will become a part of the Memorandum.
6. Any differences or disputes arising from this Memorandum should be resolved through mutual consultation and negotiations between the Parties.
7. The terms of mutual assistance, financial responsibilities, and related activities of particular programs implemented from this Memorandum will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to initiation.
8. This Memorandum will be effective for a period of **FIVE YEARS** from the date of signature, during which time it shall be reviewed to establish mutual consent as to whether the collaboration between the Parties should continue after that time.
9. The Memorandum may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by six months' notice in writing served by either party.




