Having an experience of around eight years in software field, he is a person who is very much dedicated to give back something to his village. After seeing the pathetic conditions of the farmers and the lack of mere basics, he stood strong to quit his job and to bring up some change in his village.

Apparently the triggering came to him when a series of accidents took place in his village in a very short span of 4 months. He came back to his village and started educating children the importance of education and also gave in to spread awareness among the farmers. He made it to get many people who were like minded and could help to support his cause.

The biggest problem that he had always face was to deal with the attitude of the people he said. Starting by plantation in the whole village he was successful in gathering few people to start an NGO- " Yazali-Naa Janma bhoomi". With an action plan for three years the team has started to survey the farming conditions in the whole village. In the process Mr. Lakshmi Narasimha went up to the village grama Panchayat and was saddened to know how people are migrating to cities from their own village.

The very next thing Mr.Narasimha aimed to do was to avail for all the basic amenities for their village according to the policies of the government. Very soon people saw a branch of SBI bank, water facility and development in the infrastructure of the school. With a travelling experience of one year to all the places where the best agricultural practices are carried out, Mr.Narasimha implemented all of those in his own village. In the due course the farmers there have saved around 50 lakhs. From then it did not take much time for the village of Yazali to become the model village, although it is said to be still developing. Mr. Narasimha had also had the opportunity to discuss about his dream project with the prime minister of India Dr. Narendra Modi. He also won the PM award for his idea.

Apart from this Yazali also came to be known by its younger generation. Students of Yazali municipal school have represented themselves in all the fields and domains. From higher education to national level sports they made their mark in all the aspects.

Finally the young social entrepreneur concludes his words by telling all the students to never let the curiosity of the questioning mind die down. He filled in great inspiration letting everyone know that only sky is the limit for whatsoever you dream to do. The talk then was followed by a Q&A session.
